Medical Education Policy: Posting Procedure Certifications

1. PURPOSE:

Resident bedside procedure certification is posted through MedHub, and accessible with Inpatient, Outpatient and Ambulatory Epic access, as a means of communicating to patient care providers the level of supervision that is required for residents performing bedside procedures.

2. SCOPE:

This Policy applies to all Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME), Council on Podiatric Medical Education (CPME), and Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) accredited post-graduate training programs sponsored by Carilion Medical Center (CMC).

3. DEFINITIONS:

<u>Resident</u> refers to all interns, residents, and fellows participating in CMC post graduate training programs.

4. PROCEDURE:

Each residency program develops a list of bedside procedures the residents will perform routinely during their training program. The Program Director chooses the appropriate level of supervision for every resident for each procedure based on ACGME supervision definitions and must update the procedure lists in MedHub or other CMC adopted registry within one month of when the resident's level of required supervision can be changed based on their training and demonstration of increasing competency.

The three levels of supervision that may be chosen for each procedure are as follows:

Direct Supervision:

The Supervising Physician is physically present with the resident and the patient.

Indirect Supervision

The supervising physician is not providing physical or concurrent visual or audio supervision but is immediately available to the resident for guidance and is available to provide appropriate direct supervision.

Oversight:

The Supervision Physician is available to provide review of procedures/encounters with feedback provided after the care is delivered by the resident.
