Who We Are

Carilion Drug Donation Pharmacy is designed to offer free, onsite medications for patients who have difficulty affording their prescription medications. Carilion Medication Assistance Programs (CMAP) team helps to determine if you would be eligible for the drug donation pharmacy and check if the drug donation pharmacy have prescriptions you need in stock.

CMAP team also seeks out manufacturer patient assistance programs (PAPs) for patients who need additional help with affording prescription medications.

How to Donate

Bring your unused, unopened, and non-refrigerated medications to the Medical Center Pharmacy located at Crystal Spring. We can help sort through which ones we can accept for donation or help you properly dispose of them.

✓ What We Accept

- Inhalers in the original foil wrapping
- Non-refrigerated injectable devices (e.g., Lovenox, EpiPen)
- Sealed manufacturer bottles of prescription tablets or capsules
- Unit-dose packages like blister cards

✗ What We DO NOT Accept

- Controlled substances
- Expired medications
- Incorrectly stored medications (e.g., exposure to heat or light for long time)
- Medications in amber vial
- Refrigerated medications (e.g., insulin vials or pens)
